

Norah Gaughan's Vintage Afghan



Skill Level: Intermediate

One size

Finished measurements:

Approximately 48" wide x 60" long

Materials: 4 hank or balls of Berroco Vintage or Berroco Comfort of 5 colors

Knitting needle size US 7 (4.50 mm)

Cable needle (cn)

Crochet hook, size 4.5 mm (G)

Tapestry needle

Gauge: 20 sts and 27 rows = 4" in St st

NOTE This afghan is made up of 20 different squares. They are all made individually, then sewn together following diagram in the direction shown by arrows. Cast on for all squares using long-tail method.

FINISHING Using tapestry needle and left-over yarn and whip st or mattress stitch, sew squares together following diagram. Turn squares as you work so that they go in the direction shown by arrows (bound-off edge should be at point of arrow). The numbers in the diagram refer to the squares and the letters refer to the colors. The arrows refer to the direction the square was worked.

Edging: With RS facing, using crochet hook, join D with a sl st in any corner of afghan. Work in sc around entire afghan, working 3 sc's in each corner, join with a sl st in first sc. Working from left to right, work in reverse sc around entire edge, join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in all ends and block as desired.
