



Materials:

H hook, Medium Worsted Yarn, Red, Black, and White Yarn

Size: 9.5 inches in width and 5 inches in height

Rnd 1: Red Yarn, In the Magic Circle, ch 3(counts as a dc), work 13 dc, sl st on top of the chain 3

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in the same stitch, *2 dc in each stitch around, sl st on top of the ch 3

Rnd 3: With Red yarn, ch 3, 2 dc in the next stitch, dc, *pull your black yarn through the red loop, 2 dc, then pull your red yarn through the loop, dc, 2 dc, dc, *Repeat around, You will have 7 black 2 dc, pull your red yarn through the loop and sl st on top of the chain 3

Rnd 4: With Red yarn only, Ch 3, dc in the next stitch, 2 dc in the next stitch, *dc in the next two stitches, 2 dc, Repeat around, sl st on top of the ch 3.

Rnd 5: With Red yarn, Ch 3, dc in the next two stitches, pull through black yarn through, 2 dc in the next stitch, pull through with red yarn, dc in the next three stitches, pull through with black yarn, *2 dc, pull through with red yarn, dc in the next 3 stitches, pull through black yarn 2 dc *Repeat around, pull through with red yarn and sl st on top of the ch 3. You will have 14 black 2 dc.

Rnd 6: With Red Yarn, Ch 3, dc in the next three stitches, 2 dc, *dc in the next four stitches, 2dc, *Repeat around, sl st on top of the ch 3.

Rnd 7: With White Yarn, Ch 3, dc in the next four stitches, 2 dc, *dc in the next five stitches, 2dc, *Repeat around, sl st on top of the ch 3. Fasten off and Weave in your ends.

Rnd 8: With Green Yarn, Ch 3, dc in the next five stitches, 2 dc, *dc in the next six stitches, 2dc, *Repeat around, sl st on top of the ch 3.

Fold it in half and sc around to make it look like a watermelon. sl st. Or leave it round to use as a hot pad.

Continue on: Create a ch 12 for a loop to use it as a hanger, then sc in inside and around, and fit as many sc as you can inside. Fasten off and Weave in your ends,
