PREPARE for IMPACT! Isn't that what we do daily in our nonprofits – literally and metaphorically?

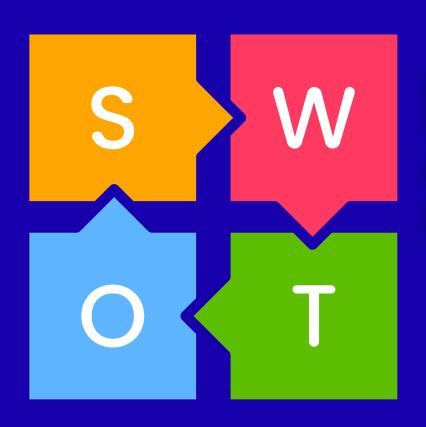
