We have 355 paid members, making up 89.4% of our membership. General Membership meetings begin at 6:00 pm.

Come to the Membership Meeting for a chance to have your Membership Dues paid by the Post for 1 year only. PUFL and Honorary Members, and BOGO are not eligible for this drawing. Yearly Paid members have a chance to have their membership paid for. You must be present at the General Membership Meeting to receive. The General Membership Meeting is on the 3rd Monday of each month. If your name is drawn and you are PRESENT, we will pay for your Membership for 1 year. If your name is drawn and you are NOT at the meeting, your name will then be placed back into the drawing for the next month's meeting.

All members registered only for 2024 should be renewed ASAP. Starting January 1, 2025, members not renewed for 2025 will be considered "Delinquent" and lose privileges with the National American Legion or Post 98. Renewing your membership will restore your privileges and support essential Legion programs for US veterans, their families, and communities.

Your \$50 membership dues will extend your membership through December 31, 2025. Election of Officers for the 2025 - 2026 Fiscal Year will be held at the May meeting. If you are interested in running for a position or would like to nominate someone, please attend the April 7th monthly meeting at 6:30 pm.

Due to a recent increase in dues at the District Level it was also necessary to increase our Units annual dues from \$35 per year to \$39 for 2026.

As our Fiscal Year, Membership Year and Dept/District Reporting Year are different I would like to explain this as we have several new members. The Fiscal Year is for tax purposes/auditing of our Unit and is from July 1st – June 31st. The Membership Year is on a calendar year from January 1st - December 31st. Early renewal starts in July, usually at the Legion Picnic. The easiest way to know if you are current with your dues is if the year on your membership card is the same calendar year we are in or is it the following year. If it's either one your membership is current. The Dept/District Reporting year is April 1st - Match 30th. This is the timeframe used for logging volunteer hours and filing the annual reports for awards at the District and Department levels.

The Auxiliary donated over \$2.200 to pay for the new ceiling tiles in the bar area. This included the hallways leading to the back door and both the men's and women's bathrooms. Stop in and check it out! It made a big difference in the overall appearance of the area.
