Commander's Call



As June comes to an end, so does the end of my Commandership. As I look at the past 2 years, I cannot help but reflect on the so many things that happened and changed during that two-year period. In July of 2019, we hit the floor running, starting with fundraisers for the Post, raising over \$7,000 in raffles, silent auctions and even a pig roast. Little did we know how important that money was going to be when in just a short time afterward, we had to shut Legion down due to the pandemic, curtailing the majority of our income and putting the Post's very existence in jeopardy. But we prevailed. We prevailed due to the very hard work of a handful of people that were dedicated to make sure that Legion Post 98 would survive. We

renegotiated the mortgage on the building, significantly lowering the mortgage payments. We negotiated a line of credit to protect us in the event of a catastrophic event causing a significant out-of-pocket expense. We changed accountants, saving us hundreds of dollars each year. Little did we know that by doing that, through the new accountant's hard work, we would benefit in new undiscovered tax breaks and rebates. Through many hours of work, our Finance Officer obtained grants and forgivable loans so we could make significant improvements to our Legion Pos such as a new kitchen that is thriving, and now we are in the process of completing a patio so we can have outside dinning. As we approach our 100-year anniversary, we are now transitioning to a new regime of leadership who will inherit a Legion that is in a much stronger financial position than when we started. I hope you will join me in welcoming them and wishing them the best of luck in the new year. I want to personally thank from the bottom of my heart all the people that worked so tirelessly to keep our Post alive over the last two years. It has been an honor and a pleasure to be your Commander over the last two years. I cannot wait to see the changes in the years to come....

Our favorite new restaurants in the Twin Cities suburbs

328 GRILL AT THE LEGION

Inside the St. Paul Park American Legion, this new operation from chef Mik German is one of our favorite new suburban additions. German, formerly of O’Gara’s and Alary’s, is at home in the dive-bar atmosphere, and cooking the food he wants to cook. And that food is, in a nutshell, dirty-good, creative bar food.



We started with some of the best cheese curds we’ve had (love the herbs in the light, shatter-crisp batter and the loving touch of house-made ranch) and a hilarious Minnesota poutine (tots, raw curds and wild rice soup) that is reminiscent of our state hotdish.

The teens in our group were fans of the straight-up 328 burger, a sizeable, but not too huge, juicy patty, adorned with American cheese, lettuce, tomato, house-made pickles and herby mayo. The adults devoured the Jalapeno Business, a spicy (but not too spicy, because Minnesota) number in which cheddar

jack, bacon and jalapenos are infused into an Angus patty, which is topped with smoked American cheese and spicy mayo. It’s honestly a masterpiece of a burger.



We also got a fried chicken sandwich, which can be left plain customized with Nashville hot spice, hot honey or buffalo. We chose the hot honey, which was a great complement to the super-crispy, juicy chicken, but left our hands all sticky. (Note to self: Bring wet wipes next time, because it’s so tasty we’ll order it again.)
