Feature Article

Smith's Fort Plantation – Virginia

This single post highlights an interesting point-of-interest while exploring the coastal Virginia area; a brief history lesson also - after all, this region is where it all started for our young country.

The story-and-a-half brick manor house that stands at the head of the trail was built sometime between 1751 and 1765.

It was laid in Flemish bond brickwork and was home to Jacob Faulcon and his family.

A gabled roof is accented with dormer windows.

Its architectural significance lies in the interior where much of the

original woodwork still exists. This is the second time I have stopped by <u>Smith's Fort Plantation</u> and unfortunately they were closed both times, so I have not had the opportunity to check out the interior.

There is a lot of history in this area. Captain John Smith's old stomping grounds!







Time to ride back to the old fort site. The sign is a bit of an exaggeration; just so happens, I'm on the right bike anyway.

Earthworks: The two-foot high earthworks are considered the oldest English structure in Virginia and are all that remains of the fort.





Not a whole lot left. The site is really nice and secluded though - with a nice overlook.

John Smith earned the title "Captain" serving with the Hapsburg cavalry along the contested border between the Austrian and Turkish empires. Given his experience, Smith no doubt recognized that Jamestown

was vulnerable to attack, particularly after exploring the surrounding terrain while trading with the Natives.

In 1609, during his tenure as president of the colony, Smith built a defensive position here. From this bluff above <u>Gray's Creek</u>, the colonists could defend themselves from redoubts against the <u>Algonquian Natives</u> and the Spanish <u>galleons</u> some feared might come to drive them from the New World.

According to Smith's <u>Generall Historie</u>, he never completed the fort because he was called back to <u>Jamestown</u> when rats infested the corn supply.

Upon <u>John Rolfe</u>'s marriage to <u>Pocahontas</u> in 1614, this tract of land was given to the couple by <u>Powhatan</u>.

The Overlook: The bluff at Smith's Fort overlooks Gray's Creek, which provided a perfect view of visitors - invited or not.





For a moment, my mind drifted off - way back in time - before this land was tamed ... and I imagined hostiles approaching in canoes and

Track Day is Here!

The MSTA/COG sport touring track day is coming up soon. On Friday, Feb 24th, we will have approximately 50 riders at <u>Jennings GP Raceway</u> in north Florida. Riders will be spending the day under the tutelage of <u>Ken</u>

Condon, one of our industry's most recognized professionals.

The question is: Will you be there? If you are already registered, bravo! If not, why not?

First, the track day is only \$150, plus a \$10 gate entry fee. For that you get an entire day on the track and in the classroom, working with one of our profession's best and most knowledgeable instructors. Ken's time is highly sought out, so we are excited that he is spending some of it with us!

If you have never been on a track, now is the time to experience it, in a relaxed, fun for-mat. "Run what you brung" is the name of the day. The only rule is no sport bikes for registered riders (You may see one or two of the instructors, under Ken's guidance, on them, but that's what they use on the track for training).

JenningsGP is one of the best courses in the country for a new or first time track experience. It is designed as a motorcycle-only, safe course, with training in mind. It is out in the country, set in the woods and very private.

Ken and his instructors will be working with groups and individuals on riding techniques designed to enhance your street skills. This is not race day or competition. This is about exploring your current riding level and working to expand it.

On the other hand, if you are comfortable with your techniques and want to experience some faster fun, in a legal venue, this is your chance. Stay safe, follow the track rules and you can have a blast, all day!

Ken and his instructors will be there to help you setup your bike for track first thing in the morning. They will familiarize you with the track and rules for safe track riding. There will be groups working



together on specific skills, and classroom time to really dive into the mechanics and physics behind the motorcycle dynamics. Riding is fun. Understanding why the motorcycle performs under various situations is even more fun, and adds both to your enjoyment and safety.

Additionally, you can arrive the afternoon before and camp for free. Power and inside, warm bathrooms and showers are available. Nearby hotels are close (15 minutes), if you prefer a less rustic approach. There will be a hot lunch provided at the track, during the lunch break. Drinks and snacks are available all day.



Florida MSTA riders will never have a better opportunity at such a fun and effective ride training day. In addition to MSTA, the COG contingent is joining us, so we get the opportunity to make new friends and goodnaturedly pick on each other!

Check the MSTA website for all the details. Becky and I will be there the afternoon before, to welcome any early arrivals and campers, to get you settled in for the evening. Come join us for an awesome day!
