8:00: Welcome, fill water bottles, breakfast (if needed), *market play*

9:00: curriculum and *sensory focus*

10:00: morning snack

10:30: outdoor freeplay, park exploration, neighborhood walks, gardening

12:15: lunch

12:45: tidy lunch space, make beds, stories/poems or *sharing*

1:00: quiet time (non-nappers are required per licensing to have 45 minutes of downtime, nappers can nap until 3:00 if needed)

3:15: afternoon snack

3:30: *choice play* (outside, inside, or lunch prep)

5:00-6:00: market play, goodbyes, pick up

Index:

market play- we keep our usable space as clutter-free as possible. Our school has a "market" that is FULL of individually-stored and user-friendly puzzles, games, manipulatives, etc. They are set up to make it easy for our children to be successful with using a binder to locate what they want to play with, have all materials on hand, and clean with limited assistance.

sensory focus- planned activities to engage a variety of senses

choice play- beyond free play, this is a time where children are allowed to choose individually whether they want to be outside, inside, or helping in the kitchen with pet care, watering plants or lunch

sharing- before rest time, we will allow the children to share special news or items. They are welcome to bring things in on any day that they want to share, provided that things are labeled in some way, not overly-precious, and remain in their cubbies for the rest of the day.
