This is a non-clinical, supervised role suitable for young professionals and both undergraduate and graduate students.

- Research and vet local, national, and virtual mental health resources
- Develop referral pathways (e.g., self-help → peer support → therapy → crisis services) and assist in decision-making frameworks
- Collaborate with staff and fellow interns to develop intake and non-clinical triage processes
- Build and maintain a resource database
