Interns interested in applying for the Spring/Summer 2026 Corporate Internship must have a solid background in either communication, business administration, or strategic planning and a strong desire to help fund suicide awareness and prevention campaigns and initiatives. The individual should also possess research knowledge and be able to generate relationships with local governments, businesses, donors, community organizations, and other nonprofits.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Research, identify, and acquire 5–10 new corporate or foundation grant opportunities using tools like LinkedIn, GuideStar, Foundation Directory, etc.
- Design and execute donor campaigns and events, including impact reports, meetings, and personalized outreach via emails, thank-you letters, newsletters, etc.
- Work with others to prepare targeted donor journeys weekly and bi-weekly through segmented media and reports.
- Participate in weekly strategy meetings to brainstorm fundraising campaigns and help manage internal donor databases.
