II Tim. 3:14-15

Purpose for Training

Prov. 23:13-14 says, “Do not withhold discipline from a child; if you punish him with the rod, he will not die. Punish him with the rod and save his soul from death.

This death is speaking of “spiritual” death not physical death. Parents sometimes feel they will mess-up their relationship with their child or the child will resent them. But correction will not kill them, but it will prevent some foolish moves/mistakes later on in life.
