



Qualifying is easy! Veterans must live in Elk Grove (or in the South Sacramento County area) and must have been honorably discharged. A photo ID and DD-214 are required.

In addition, financial assistance is available to veterans purchasing a home. Two veterans each year will receive up to \$5,000 each to use towards a down payment or closing costs. Priority consideration is given to homeless veterans and those at risk of becoming homeless.
