ME:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of who you would like to be when you grow up. Draw a picture of yourself doing what you would like to do when you grow up.
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of yourself with a friend or family member. What are you doing? Cooking? Playing a game? Visiting a place?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of yourself displaying one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit (i.e. Love, Joy, Peace, etc.). Who helps you become more loving? More patient? More gentle? Can we be any of these ways without Him?



FAMILY:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your whole family. Who is who? Add details to your picture.
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of someone you look up to in your family. Why do you look up to them? Include this in your picture.

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of what family means to you. Are there other people you consider family? (i.e. people at school or church). Draw a picture of them.



SCHOOL:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your school.. What do you love about your school? Include yourself in the picture.
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your Teacher. What do you love about your teacher?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of what you're thankful for at your school (i.e. your friends, playground, schoolwork). Yes, I said schoolwork. :)
- Think about a place on campus (i.e. Library, playground, or Snack Shack). Draw a picture of it. Include yourself and your friends in the picture!



CREATION:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your favorite animal. What is it?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a garden. What is in it?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a plant. What kind of plant is it? Is it in your backyard or somewhere else?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a flower. What kind of flower is it? What color is it? Does it grow in sunlight or indoors?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a butterfly. What color is your butterfly? What is its design?



PLACES:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your favorite place to go. Why is this your favorite place to go?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of the ocean. Are there animals in it? If so, what kind?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a forest. Are there animals in it? If so, what kind?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of a jungle. Are there animals in it? If so, what kind?



HISTORY/CULTURE:

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of someone you look up to in history. Why do you look up to them?
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of someone who lives in another country. Where do they live? What is their culture like?



GOD/BIBLE:

- Choose one of the following Bible Verses and draw/sketch/color a picture of it:
 - I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well (Psalm 139:14).
 - "I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations" (Jeremiah 1:5).
 - Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12).
 - Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come (2 Corinthians 5:17).
 - But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the LORD sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart" (1 Samuel 16:7).
 - For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago (Ephesians 2:10).
 - When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him? (Psalm 8:3-4).
- Think about your favorite book in the Bible. Is it the story of David and Goliath? Jesus feeding the people with only five loaves of bread and two fish? Or Jesus' birth? Draw a picture of it. Include yourself in the picture if you'd like!
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of the armor of God (Ephesians 6:10-17). Include yourself wearing it if you'd like!
- Who is your favorite character in the Bible? Why are they your favorite character in the Bible? Draw/sketch/color a picture of him/her.

- Think about the fruits of the Holy Spirit. Choose one of them and draw a picture of it.
- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of what you are thankful for in your life. What has God given you that you can share with others?
- Think about the attributes/characteristics of God (i.e. Loving, Kind, Just, Holy, Faithful). Draw/Sketch/Color a picture that reminds you of His Love, Kindness, Justice, Holiness, Faithfulness in your life and/or in the lives of others.

- Draw/Sketch/Color a picture of your favorite holiday (i.e. Christmas, Easter, Thanksgiving). Why is it your favorite holiday? How do you celebrate that holiday?
