

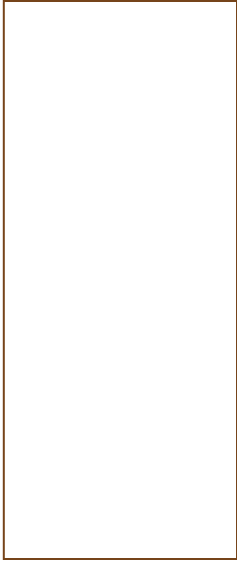

JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ is **GOD in the flesh**
(100% man and 100% divine)

The New Age movement reflects that man is divine, and is a co-creator with God/Higher Power/Universe, as the hope for future peace and harmony (CARM: <https://carm.org/new-age-what>).

- By promoting that human beings are divine, the New Age movement discounts the identity and work of Jesus Christ on the cross (John 1:1; John 1:14).
- Man cannot save himself, nor can he heal himself. He is a sinner and is dead in his flesh (John 8:24; Romans 5:8).



GOD's LOVE

The Gospel (John 3:16): Jesus Christ died to pay the penalty for our sins so that we might become children of God through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

To accept Jesus Christ as your Lord & Savior:

Admit you're a sinner. You are not able to bridge the gap between you and God through your own effort. "Trying harder" is not the answer; acknowledging that you can't save yourself is.

Believe in Jesus and what He has done. To believe in Jesus is to agree with what the Bible says about Him and what He says about Himself. Jesus was 100% man and 100% God. He died on the cross as a sacrifice to make payment for your sins and then rose from the dead, conquering death for all who believe in Him.

Commit to follow Jesus. Commitment is believing that Jesus alone saves you and living in that truth.

Here is a sample prayer to follow when accepting Jesus Christ as your Lord & Savior:

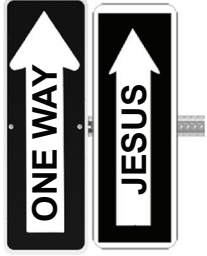

I invite Jesus to become the Lord of my life, to rule and reign in my heart from this day forward. Please send your Holy Spirit to help me obey You, and to do Your will for the rest of my life. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."

NOT ALL PATHS LEAD TO GOD

I was a soul-searching seeker who desperately wanted love, peace and freedom in the world. I dreamt BIG, gazed at the stars, and sought after a fairy tale life. As a result, I started a *spiritual journey* that reflected that all human beings had the ability to access a divine power within them to positively change the world. *I began to believe all paths led to God.*

Using methods such as: the law of attraction, creative visualization, and mind science, I created my own love—peace—freedom filled reality. I achieved *enlightenment* with the man whom I thought was my soul mate and felt a sense of *oneness* with the Earth. *I also started to receive spiritual guidance from a higher power I thought was light. In my eyes, all was perfect.*

Until one day...The man whom I thought was my soul mate abruptly died.

After his passing, I used the same spiritual practices to attempt to heal myself from grief. I received spiritual guidance that urged me to continue to be a contributor to creating love, peace and freedom in the world. But after 6 months, I couldn't stand my grief anymore and desperately cried out, "Use me! Use me!" I didn't know who I was calling out to; I just screamed at the top of my lungs for help.

GOD's GRACE

Over the next 3 days, the True Living God revealed through several occurrences that the spiritual guidance I received along my spiritual journey was actually evil. The methods I applied to my life were a part of the New Age Movement (see back for more info).

After seeing a glimpse of the dark realities of the New Age Movement, I came to my senses—I was deceived, wrong, and needed a Savior. As soon as I admitted I was a sinner and accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior, He delivered me from the path that would have led me to eternal separation from God. Even though I didn't deserve it, Jesus renewed my mind from two years of New Age brainwashing, delivered me from oppression, healed me from my grief, and removed the "scales" from my eyes.

"I could suddenly see that there is only ONE way to God: Salvation through Jesus Christ."

SALVATION is: By Grace alone, Through Faith alone, In Christ alone.

GOD's TRUTH

"For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people"(Romans 5:17).

In the Garden of Eden, Adam was the first man who sinned against God by disobeying His command to not eat the fruit from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, leading him and all human beings born thereafter to spiritual death (Gen. 3:3).
