Brucella canis Antibody by IFA

Negative

Positives at 1:100 are suggestive of brucellosis. Highly recommend confirmatory testing using AGID methodology.

Positives at 1:200- Highly recommend confirmatory testing using AGID methodology and consultation with a clinical pathologist.

Titers begin at 1:50, with positives titered to 1:200. Low titers (at 1:50) may indicate early infection, antibody response blunted by the use of antibiotics, or a false-positive due to cross-reacting antigens. Recommend either retesting in 30 days or confirmatory testing using AGID methodology.
