City of Lake Stevens Projects:

- Railings City fixed railings on 1st St SE after it was hit twice by drivers.
- Lane markers City put down lane markers to help direct drivers through the curve on 1st St SE.

- Signage Jerry has contacted City to replace signage because of fading.

Many homeowners have not paid their dues. Before 2012, there was \$15,885 that was past-due. For 2013, there is \$14,203. Total past due is \$30,088.

What do the dues cover?

The dues cover the maintenance of the greenbelts, retention ponds, parks, playgrounds, two sports courts, and landscaping of the common areas. It also covers insurance and taxes. We, the board, ask that you pay your dues so we have the funds to maintain the association and keep it looking nice for the residents. If you have a hardship, the board can work with you and set-up a payment plan.

What happens if a homeowner doesn't pay their dues?

The association will place a lien on their house, and that gets added to the balance that's owed. Each time the association has to place a lien, it costs the association \$110 that we don't collect until the home is sold. This cuts into our operating expenses for years.

Playgrounds and sports courts:

The playgrounds and sports courts are overdue for major maintenance. With many homeowners past-due on their dues, we can only address the items that are unsafe for children. If there are monies left-over, we will look at getting the rest of the items fixed. Below is a list of what needs to be fixed at each playground and sports courts.

Across from big rock on 83rd:

- Wood boundary border needs to be replaced and rebar not exposed
- Replace ground cover (chips) and holes need to be filled in
- Asphalt repaired
- Repair metal flashing on slide
- Remove paint from hand holds
- Remove graffiti and pressure wash bench
- Get estimates for new playground equipment

Big rock on 83rd:

- New signage
- Fill in holes
- Stump removal
- Clean debris behind rock
- Clear brush around rock
- Replace board on fence

Sports court on 83rd Dr and 1st Pl:

- Fix or replace backboard and net
- Pressure wash court and retaining wall
- Fix hole in chain link fence

Playground and detention pond on 3rd St and 84th Ave:

- Wood boundary border needs to be replace and rebar not exposed
- Replace ground cover (chips) and holes need to be filled in
- Pressure wash bench
- Repair or replace slide
- Repair hole in chain link fence and replace lock on fence

Sports court on 3rd St and 85th Ave:

- Pressure wash court, retaining wall and fence
- Replace net
- Remove crank mechanism on post

Small Park on 83rd Dr & 1st Pl:

• Pressure wash park bench

Other needs around the association:

- Replace missing caps on white vinyl fence posts
- Estimate for bark and or removing bark and plastic ground cover and replacing with grass
- Dog poop stations
- NGPA signs
- Trails signage clean or replace
