



INFORMED CONSENT FOR IN-PERSON SERVICES DURING COVID-19

This document contains important information about our decision to resume in-person services in light of the COVID-19 public health crisis. Please read this carefully and let me know if you have any questions.

Decision to Meet Face-to-Face

We have agreed to meet in person for some or all future sessions. If there is a resurgence of the pandemic or if other health concerns arise, however, we may decide to meet via telehealth for everyone's well-being. You understand that by coming to the office, you are assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus (or other public health risk).

Your Responsibility to Minimize Your Exposure

To obtain services in person, you agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone safer from exposure and possible sickness. Please initial to show your agreement.

- You will only keep your in-person appointment if you are symptom free. ____
- You will take your temperature before coming to each appointment. If it is elevated (100 Fahrenheit or more), or if you have other symptoms of the coronavirus, you agree to cancel the appointment or proceed using telehealth. If you wish to cancel for this reason, I won't charge you our normal cancellation fee. ____
- You will wait in your car until no earlier than 5 minutes before our appointment time. ____
- You will wash your hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer when you enter the building. ____
- You will wear a mask in all areas of the office ____
- You will keep a distance of 6 feet ____
- If you are bringing your child, you will make sure that your child follows all of these sanitation and distancing protocols. ____
- If you have a job that exposes you to other people who are infected, you will immediately let us know. ____
- If a resident of your home tests positive for the infection, you will immediately let us know and we will then [begin] resume treatment via telehealth. ____

We may change the above precautions if additional local, state or federal orders or guidelines are published.

Office Safety Precautions in Effect During the Pandemic

Let's Talk is taking the following precautions to protect our patients and help slow the spread of the coronavirus:

- Office seating in the waiting room is **not** available at this time.
- We will have available masks, face shields and gloves for all therapists.
- We will maintain safe distancing.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol will be available in the therapy rooms
- We will only have hard plastic toys that can easily be sanitized available to children.
- Toys, tables and chairs will be thoroughly sanitized after each use.
