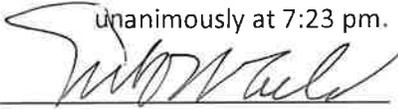
- Motion made: by Cindy Oblock, seconded by Mark Tarle to adopt the proposed 2026 Budget. Motion passed unanimously.
