A. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS – FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Storm Sewers

- 24" replacement on Kiski Avenue and South 5th Street.
 - A. PA small water and sewer grant.
 - B. HOP permitting through PennDOT – cost estimate to reflect
- Evaluate all other streets for surface and subsurface drainage needs – future.

2. Roadwork

- PNG gas line relocation in plaza – checklist of procedure to be established.
 - A. Curb to urb ordinance – solicitor consultation for borings
- Terrace Avenue bridge replacement – 16' x 12' – closed due to hole in bridge – structural.
- Roads requiring curb to curb repaving.
 - A. 9th Street
 - B. Oakhill Avenue
- Streetlights and traffic lights
 - A. \$5,000.00 monthly electric bill – replace lights with LED lights.
 - B. Traffic light upgrades and crosswalk improvements – replace loop sensors with cameras/radar – chase ARLE grant money.

3. Borough MS4 Permit

- MS4 Annual progress report submitted to DEP
- Doug Siler of GTE to coordinate MS4 progress meeting with Borough staff.
- A clean river reminder to Borough residents: Before draining your swimming pool for the season. Allow the pool to set uncovered for several days to let the chlorine dissipate into the air, then drain your pool to a grassy or gravel area to allow your pool water to filter through the ground before it reaches the Kiski River.

4. Miscellaneous work to be considered

- Recreation
 - A. Boat launch
 - B. Owens Grove Park improvements – grant application submitted through Bob Regola, includes walking trail/parking lot.
 - C. Equipment replacement
- Riverfront Property – investigate
- River Trail – currently ends at Scenic Drive in a cul-de-sac. Connect back to Route 56.
- Mapping
