We met a fellow Club member David Chenoweth (Judy was home sick). At the show who was there to win his First Junior award on his 59 Jeep.


Paul and David both won their class First Junior Award!!! Paul took his 40 woodie wagon Pontiac and David his 59 Jeep. Congratulations!!!!

History, February, 2023

The November, 1998 issue of the Running Board contains a long President's message from Dom Disarro. The club was very active at that time. Al Brehm, the membership chairman, reported the membership was at 158, with 101 renewals. The club was doing a car display at Sam's Club. They also reported a "desperate" appeal from the Naples City Council for 14 old cars for their 75th Anniversary Parade. President Dom suggested the members should do this to keep in the good graces of the city council. The club also had a car show scheduled at the Library.

The club had a new refreshment chair in the person of John Aibel. He said he was sure his wife Susan would help him, but it was noted she was not at the meeting.

The club had two static displays coming up. The first was to be at Marco Towne Center and the second was the March 13 Depot Show. Volunteers were needed for both events. There was a clip board passed around for the Library Car Show and 40 people had already signed up to bring their cars.

Legislative

Celebration time, California!

The state legislature passed a SAN-supported resolution (A.C.R. 176) celebrating the history and culture associated with automobile cruising. This resolution encourages local officials and law enforcement to work with local car clubs to conduct safe cruising events. Highlighting the automotive community's positive spirit and cultural contributions, the resolution recognizes the vital roles of legendary cruising strips and car club activities spanning the state.

Protection of Motorsports Act

December 22, 2022: SEMA and Performance Racing Industry (PRI) must share that despite strong Congressional backing and extraordinary support from the racing community, the 2021-2022 Congressional session is ending without passage of the Recognizing the Protection of Motorsports (RPM) Act.

Key negotiators in Congress could not reach an agreement on bill language that balanced the need for federal law to protect racers and motorsports parts businesses from EPA enforcement with reasonable measures to ensure that race parts are not used on vehicles driven on roads and public highways.

The RPM Act made incredible progress in the 2021-2022 session of Congress. In addition to more than 1.5 million letters advocating for the RPM Act from the grassroots motorsports community to Congress, SEMA and PRI worked with Richard Petty to meet personally with key lawmakers in Washington, DC, and with NHRA Top Fuel driver Antron Brown to testify before the U.S. Senate Environment and Public Works Committee.

SEMA and PRI thank the RPM Act's lead sponsors, the Senate Environment & Public Works (EPW) Committee, and the House Energy & Commerce Committee for their efforts to advance the RPM Act over the course of this year. Their leadership was integral throughout this process, despite the outcome.

"We wouldn't have made it this far without this incredible effort by so many of our members," said SEMA President and CEO Mike Spagnola. "The RPM Act was one of the most bipartisan bills in the 117th Congress with over 165 lawmakers cosponsoring the legislation. SEMA and PRI will leverage the momentum we built during this congressional session, assess the current challenges the industry faces, and chart a new path forward for the industry's advocacy efforts at both the federal and state levels.



















Car and Art Show in Punta Gorda....Hank Feinberg
