

NEW JERSEY INTRODUCES BILL SUPPORTING INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES

Overview: New Jersey introduced SAN-supported legislation (S.2252), prohibiting the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) from adopting California's ban on new gas- or diesel-powered vehicles.

The SAN believes New Jersey families, not the government, should be allowed to choose the vehicle technology that best serves them and their families.

PENNSYLVANIA LEGISLATURE PASSES BILL ALLOWING DOORLESS DRIVING

Overview: Pennsylvania lawmakers passed SAN-supported legislation (S.B. 298) to allow doorless driving for vehicles such as Jeeps and Broncos. This bill addresses the current legal restriction in Pennsylvania, making it the only state where driving without doors, except for offroading, is illegal. The proposed legislation mandates safety measures, including the requirement of side view mirrors when doors are removed and maintaining seatbelt protections for minors. **The bill now awaits final approval or veto by Governor**

Peter's '96 Toyota "Classic"...Peter Blackford

Here is the story of Peter's recent car purchase. It appeared on the cover of last month's Running Board with an invitation from Peter to identify the car.

On the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the company, Toyota sought to add an example of

their first model, the AA, to the corporate museum. Unfortunately, there was not a single one to be found. Therefore, a copy was commissioned and hand made in much the same manner as it was done in 1936. That car still resides in the museum, and was recently seen in an episode of Jay Leno's Garage.

Fast forward another decade to the occasion of the 60th anniversary, when the decision was made to manufacture a commemorative model in the spirit of the



AA. As is evident from the styling, the design of the 1936 car was inspired by the Chrysler Airflow and much of that carried through with the commemorative model, officially named the Classic. Just 100 of the Classics were commissioned, built body-on-frame using the chassis borrowed from the 5th generation HiLux pickup truck. Even the horsepower is similar to the original at just under 100, now produced by four cylinders in place of the six used in the day. With an automatic transmission, power brakes and steering, air conditioning and power windows it's a great car to drive and show at AACA events.
