Father and Son Set Cannonball Record In Stock Audi A3

A father and son recently set the new speed record for unmodified vehicles for the Cannonball Run from New York City to Redondo Beach Ca. They used a completely stock Audi A3, with no backup fuel tanks, no spotters, airplanes, etc. Their time of 40hrs,23 minutes beat the previous record by 28 minutes. They averaged around 90mph with a peak of 130mph. They were pulled over one time for improper use of turn signals at ~80mph, but received only a warning.

The record time for modified vehicles, with spotters, extra fuel tanks, etc. is reported at 25 hrs, 39 minutes as of August 2025. Note all of this is completely unsanctioned, illegal, etc...
