2025 Show Status... New location and date

Your Show Committee has delivered again! After receiving the report of the Site selection sub-committee, the Show Committee has selected a site and date for next year's show. Mark your calendars: Saturday, March 15, 2025 at the North Naples Church, 6000 Goodlette-Frank Road,

Naples.

A site selection sub-committee was appointed because of issues which arose in planning this year's show at the Depot, and which are likely to arise regarding any future use of that site. These issues included not having Saturdays freely available for a show, not having the Depot facility open for accessibility to restrooms, not having parking for trailers, not having space for a car corral, not having convenient public parking available and permit difficulties with Naples.

The North Naples Church site fulfilled the criteria utilized by the sub-committee (which were set forth in the minutes of our May 11, 2024 meeting). Additionally the administrative staff of the church has been very accommodating, enthusiastic and supportive of our efforts to locate a suitable site for the show. The North Naples Church site will allow us to increase the number of cars displayed, consider having a car corral, and has space for visitor parking. Trailers can be accommodated and there is an on-site restroom trailer. There are shade trees on sections of the site. The site is visible from Goodlette Road, a major traffic artery. The Church is not charging any fee for the use of the facility.

Legislative

Action Required: Tell Congress to Pass Resolution to Stop EPA Regulation Mandating EVs

Overview: In response to the EPA's recently finalized tailpipe emissions standards for Model Years 2027 to 2032, which require automakers to ramp up electric vehicle sales to comply, U.S. Representative John James (R-MI) and U.S. Senator Pete Ricketts (R-NE) introduced Congressional Review Act (CRA) resolutions, H.J. Res. 136 and S.J. Res. 75, to overturn the regulation. SEMA strongly supports these CRA resolutions, which simply require a majority vote in both the Senate and House in order to pass.

Under the EPA's tailpipe emissions standards, up to 83% of new vehicles sold by 2032 could be forms of electric vehicles. Congress must pass this CRA resolution to stop the EPA's regulatory overreach, allow consumers to have the freedom to purchase the vehicle that works best for their families, and prevent vehicle manufacturers from being forced to meet unrealistic mandates driven by the most aggressive light-duty emissions regulations in U.S. history
