Here is the information from the By-Laws that were discussed at the November Meeting. The information for the December Elections will be discussed at the December Meeting on the 15th. If you have questions before the meeting please refer to the Bylaws page 6 of 17, Section 2 at the

top. Article VII & election of Directors

Section 1. Nomination. Nomination for election to the Board of Directors shall be made by a Nomination Committee, composed of a Chairman and two other Association members. The President, with concurrence of the Board of Directors, shall at the October Board of Directors' meeting appoint the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall make as many nominations for election to the Board of Directors as it shall in its discretion determine, but not less than the number of vacancies to be filled. Nominations by the Committee shall be subject to the approval of the candidate prior to presentation to the membership. Nominations shall be presented to the membership at the November general membership meeting. Nominations for all Director positions open for election may also be made from the floor at the November meeting. The Nominating Committee shall announce said nominations at the regular November meeting and publish said nominations in the December Residents' Newsletter. Nomination shall be closed at the end of the November meeting. An election is not required unless there are more candidates nominated than vacancies that exist on the board.
