



CREATIVE ENDEAVORS (QUILT CLUB) MAY 2024


Our group meets every Wednesday at 1:00 in the clubhouse craft room. We are doing a variety of activities. We create quilts for the veterans in our village and make items for

CHERRY BERRIES ON A CLOUD

FIRST LAYER

- 6 egg whites
- ½ tsp cream of tartar
- I ½ tsp salt
- 1 ³/₄ cups of sugar



SECOND LAYER

- · 6 ounces cream cheese, softened.
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 cups whipping cream (whipped)or Cool Whip
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 2 cups miniature marshmallows
- Third Layer
- 1 can cherry pie filling
- 10 ounces raspberries or strawberries, thawed and drained
- 1 tsp lemon juice
- 1. Beat the first 3 ingredients until frothy. Add the sugar slowly. Beat for at least 15 minutes or more. Put this in a 9x13 pan greased with Crisco.
- 2. Bake at **275 degrees** for 60 minutes. Turn the oven off and leave in the oven until it is cool—do not peek!
- 3. Combine the ingredients for a second layer and spread over the cold torte; set in refrigerator overnight or longer.
- 4. Combine drained berries, pie filling and lemon juice. You can spoon over each individual piece or spread over the entire lessert. Enjoy!




