- One of the biggest indicators of a scam is a website URL that is very similar to, but slightly different from the true website.
- Ship to a location you know someone can be available to bring it inside or send it to a secure location.
- Protect yourself against malicious software by only downloading apps from places like Galaxy Apps, the App Store, Amazon App Store, and Google Play.
