



## 2026 Canfield 4<sup>th</sup> of July Antique Car Registration



Dear Parade Participant,

The Canfield 4th of July Committee cordially invites your organization to take part in our 2026 4th of July Parade. This year's activities will take place on Saturday, July 4, 2026. As usual, the parade will begin leaving the fairgrounds at 10:10 a.m., to arrive in the Village Green by about 10:30 a.m. Line-up at the Canfield Fairgrounds will begin at 8:30 a.m. All entries must be in their assigned position no later than 9:45 a.m.

**Please complete and mail the enclosed Registration Form by June 10, 2026.** We have also included the above QR code, linked to a Google form which can be submitted electronically. **Registrations received after June 10<sup>TH</sup>, 2026 will not be accepted and participation will not be allowed.** After entry forms have been received, you will be contacted with further details. Please be patient, you will not be contacted until all registrants have been assigned in the line-up. If you are not participating in this year's parade but would like to stay on the mailing list please indicate that on the Registration Form. Registration Forms can be submitted as follows:

Participants registering as a 'float' must adhere to a definition of a 'float', described as a decorated three-dimensional figure or scene, mounted on a wheeled chassis that participates in a procession as part of a specific celebration. Most parade floats are self-propelled, although they may also be towed by another vehicle or pulled by animals. Non-decorated vehicles will not be permitted in the parade. If you are responsible for more than one entry, please copy & complete a form for each.

### PARADE RULES & PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES WERE ESTABLISHED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Assure the safety of all parade entrants and spectators;
- Keep the parade moving at a steady pace;
- Maintain the traditional parade atmosphere that we all enjoy and expect

### GENERAL RULES

- **All participants MUST register by June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026 – Late entries will NOT be accepted;**
- Distribution of items other than candy/refreshments is NOT permitted (i.e., no fliers, coupons, etc.);
- Throwing candy from a vehicle/float is NOT permitted. To distribute candy, you must have at least two designated candy-walkers. Candy-walkers must keep pace with the vehicle/float, with one walking along each side, near the white line of the roadway;
- Bullhorns are NOT permitted. The use of a sound system must be pre-approved by the committee;
- Water-propelling devices (i.e., squirt guns) and water balloons are NOT permitted;
- Semi-trucks, construction vehicles, extended trailers, or vehicles deemed unsafe by Canfield PD will NOT be permitted and any vehicle used MUST have current insurance;
- All animal entries must be followed by participant-supplied clean-up crew;
- Vehicles/Floats must keep pace with the parade. Stopping a vehicle/float causes gaps and delays for spectators, and also forces all others to stop. All participants are expected to continue moving forward, finishing at the Middle School parking lot.

### FOR PROFIT BUSINESS PARTICIPANTS

- A \$100 minimum entry donation is required and can be mailed in advance of the parade;
- Vehicle/Float must be decorated using a patriotic theme;
- Participation must be pre-approved by the committee and is limited to one vehicle.

### COMPLIANCE

These parade rules & guidelines have been established to enhance the safety and enjoyment for everyone involved. Compliance by participants has resulted in great parades for many years and is required to ensure the same for the future. Committee members and officers with Canfield PD are stationed throughout the parade route and will enforce all rules. Failure to comply with the rules and guidelines may result in immediate removal from the parade and exclusion from future events.
