

May Meeting Minutes

President called the meeting to order at 7pm.

Introductions were given

President motioned to accept old minutes, it was seconded and so passed.

Women's Gathering: taken off the table

K-State and the Pond: taken off the table.

The President discussed the pond and it was motioned to cancel and to try another time this year, it was seconded and so passed.

Easter Egg Hunt: was also cancelled due to the Covid-19.

BBQ: was discussed that we had a rain date of Sept. 12, 2020. The President motioned to cancel the BBQ on June 27th and have it on Sept. 12, 2020, it was seconded and so passed.

Playground: It still to be torn down and that will need to wait until the COVID-19 passes. President tabled.

Skid Steer and Tires: President tabled

Resolution Meeting: Tabled

Lots around the Community Building: Treasurer asked Lisa at the courthouse about the lots, she told the Treasurer that she was going to discuss it with the County Commissioners and see if they will give them or charge Lakeshore for them.

Pool: It was discussed that the pool needs work and that the Governor is not allowing pools to open until Mid to late June if at all and that the pool needs work. The President motioned to close the pool, due to COVID-19 and the pool will need repairs before opening, it was seconded and so passed.

Stop Signs and Neighborhood Watch Signs: Two were replaced and the President said that if he gets some clear days he will try and get them put up.

Community Sign and Flagpole: New ones are up and waiting on letters. During the discussion the President motioned to use stencil and paint the lettering on, it was seconded and so passed.

Secretary motioned to dedicate the Flag/Flag Pole to the Veterans that have served and that are serving from our Community, it was seconded and so passed.

Tennis Court/Parking Lot: President makes a motion to have poles taken down from the tennis court and make the North Side a Parking Lot and the SW a Park and the SE a Basketball Court, it was seconded and so passed.

Roads: President said most roads got rock and some haven't but he will need 2 or 3 more loads to finish up. President motioned to put speed bumps up along Delaware and Quail Hill, it was seconded and so passed.

Valley View: People ran over the road closure signs it will need to be replaced.

Jeremy Pickens is willing to rent Lakeshore his equipment and he will donate his time to do some FEMA work out here, he will put it in writing and the board will review it.

Paula Lane: Secretary will contact the County about 110th and Paula Lane in fixing the ditch so the run off of rain water will not destroy Paula Lane.

Flower Committee: Tabled

Siren: It was hit with Lightning and it cost \$3000 to repair, Emergency Management paid for half and Lakeshore paid for half, of \$1500 each. Emergency Management would still like for Lakeshore to remove the trees from in front of the siren. President said he will try and get that done.

Community Center and the Guttering: Treasurer discussed about how the guttering is not functioning the way it is suppose to, she will try and get 3 bids for the Guttering repair.

Clean up around Pond: Discussion began about cleaning around the Pond and Parking Issues. **Secretary motioned to not place no parking signs and it was seconded and so passed.** President discussed the South Pond and wants to continue the road from the sewer.

President motions to contact lawyer to deal with property around South Pond and Property of Lakeshores being used as personal property, it was seconded and so passed.

PPE's: Discussion began about the Emergency Management had some available to Lakeshore and will continue to try and provide more.

President motioned to put Press up for sale for \$300, it was seconded and so passed.

Sand Spreader and Plow: Sand spreader will be hauled off for scrap and the funds will go to the Recreation Fund.

Freezer: Discussion began about putting the little freezer up on Market Place for \$100 no less than \$50.

Shed for the Community Center: Tabled

President motioned to sell the Garage Sale stuff on Market Place, it was seconded and so passed.

County Property: It was discussed that the Board needed to contact the County Commissioners about Property of the Counties being used as Personal Property.
