## May 21st Special Board Meeting

The President brought the meeting to order at 7:02 pm

Introductions were given

The President spoke and asked James- Director of Emergency Management for Jefferson County, to speak.

James spoke about how they would like to help Jefferson County 911 dispatchers, police officers, firemen and first responders and so on have better communications in the county. He discussed how there are dead zones through the county that officers and so on are not able to communicate with dispatch or vise versa. He brought up how the lots in T-section (west side) of Lakeshore Estates was owned by the county and how the lot in which once was a park ( Park Tract B) would be a great place to put a tower for communication through the county. By placing it there, it had the right elevation, it had the right amount of acreage that would be needed and so on. He mentioned that Mercury Wireless would like to be placed on the tower, and that would be another option for Lakeshore Estates community, also he was looking into cell phone providers to see if they would be interested in being on the tower as well. This was all preliminary, nothing is set in stone, they don't even have the funding for this project yet and that this is just a place in which they were looking and believed that this would work for Jefferson County.

He would like to limit the height of the tower to 195 feet.

It was opened to the floor for those to ask questions.

There will be more meetings on this with Lakeshore Estates, this is just an information meeting and there will be more information meetings when there is more to give.

It was asked if Lakeshore Community would get to vote on this and the answer was no. However, the board feels that the community should have a say in it. The board has the final vote, when and if there is a vote to be taken.

The Board thanked him for coming out and explaining what their ideas were with the community and the board.

It was discussed about having a possible work session on June 23<sup>rd</sup> at 4:30 pm

President motioned to not open pool on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May due to weather, it was seconded and so passed.
