### Old Business

1. An Addendum to the Consumer Confidence Report will be sent out to residents along with the July Water Bill in a 1<sup>st</sup> Class envelope on July 10th. Plenty of time before due date.
2. The Certified Letter was sent to 9992 Sioux Dr. and the resident did not appear to protest. At this time, the Certified Letter 'Receipt' has not been returned to us so we do not know if resident received it or not. RWD10 will proceed with the forfeiture of the meter.
3. On the July water bill the \$1 increase was mentioned in the 'note' section of the bill informing residents of the \$1 increase which will start in August, 2025.

### New Business

1. Doug Helmke gave a Fantastic presentation of the 2025 Municipal Water Conservation Plan. RWD10 approved the Plan and signed off on it. A few questions were raised as to 'how & when' to determine any Drought periods where residents would need to conserve. A suggestion was made to contact Keith Jeffers and ask him for any notices that might be in effect for the Jefferson Co. area, if he would forward those on and make us aware. Contact will be made by Deb Davis.
2. Steve's Report: 1.) Core & Main updated a few items and made some suggestions as to updating our entire system. A Cost sheet was presented and tabled until our representative can present the benefits to us. 2.) KRWA representative will be meeting with Steve to finalize maps in the coming weeks. 3.) There was a resident who was concerned about one of the 'Tax Sale Properties' possibly stealing water as it has no meter and it appeared there was a 'hose hooked up to a pump' on the property. Steve checked it out and this is not happening. Otherwise, all else is good.
