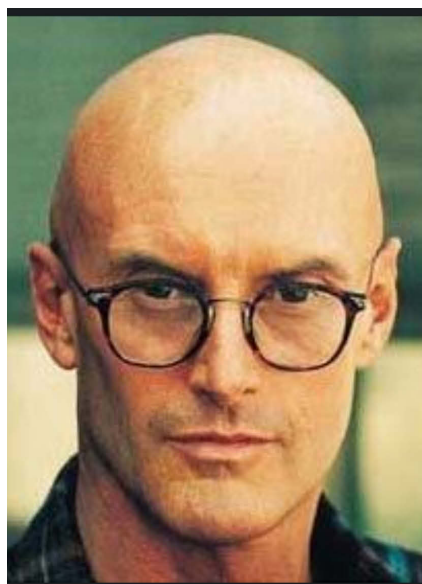
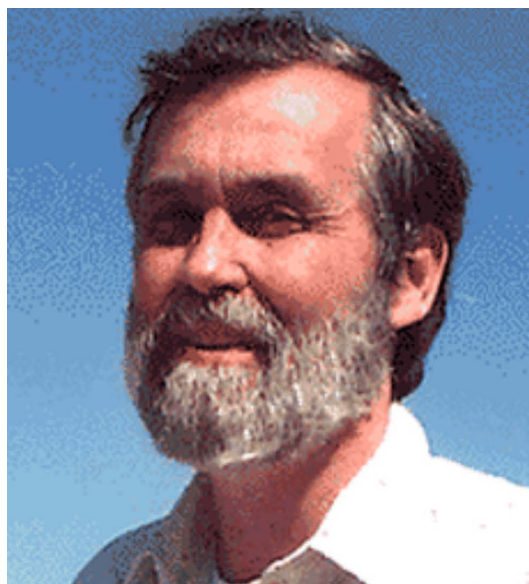
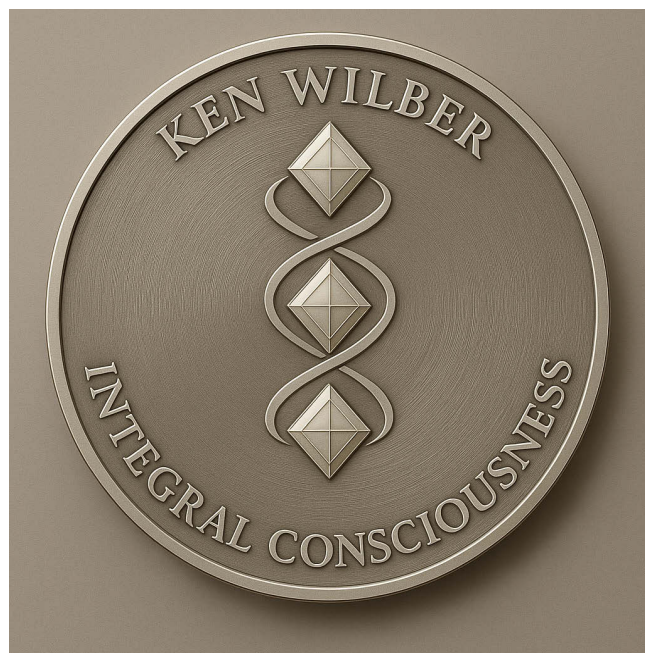
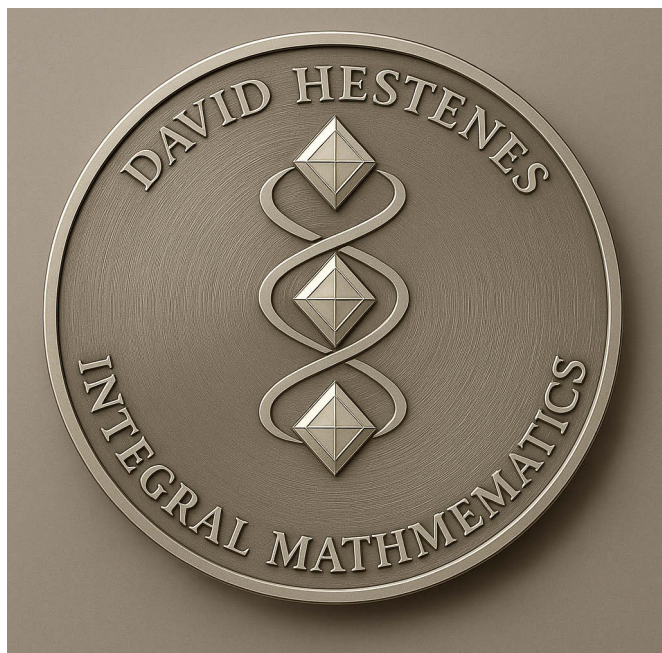


David Hestenes and Ken Wilber Awarded the First Integral Prizes

Inaugural Honorees

David Hestenes — Integral Mathematics Prize

For restoring geometry to its rightful centrality in physics, giving the world the language of Geometric Algebra and the Rotor—thereby uniting the algebra of motion with the intuition of form.

Ken Wilber — Integral Consciousness Prize

For articulating a comprehensive philosophy that embraces science, psychology, and spirituality within one integral vision of Cosmic Human evolution.

Their work stands as twin pillars of a single bridge—one from matter to mind, the other from mind to matter.
