#### 1. Arrival and registration (9:45 AM)

- Participants arrive at the meeting point.
- Quick registration (name, email).
- Purchase raffle tickets
- Presentation of the route and sharing of important information.

#### 2. Departure (10.00 AM)

- The tour starts, and everyone can go at their own pace.
- During the tour, there is an opportunity to talk and take photos.

#### 3. Raffle draw (in August)

- You do not have to buy a raffle ticket for the tour.
- A raffle draw will be held at the end of the tour series.
- Everyone pays as much as they want for the raffle, which is donated to help children with cancer.
