

The Sandy Beaver Pintwood Derby

Rules

1. All cars must meet the following specifications:
 - a. Dimensions: 2 3/4" wide INCLUDING Wheels and Axles
 - b. 5" tall maximum (Track to top of car)
 - c. 7" long maximum
 - d. 4 1/2" Wheelbase (Axle to Axle)
 - e. Powered only by gravity - no propulsion or magnets etc.
 - f. Maximum Weight: 5 Oz
 - g. All four wheel must be installed
 - h. No loose items
2. Cars that do not pass initial inspection may be adjusted in order to meet specifications. The American Legion WILL NOT provide tools to modify/adjust cars prior to registration. This is the responsibility of the participant.
3. All lubrication must be dry powder or completely dry before turn in.
4. Cars that are not registered or fail to meet specification by the start time of the race will forfeit the opportunity to qualify for a prize. All cars may race at the discretion of the host.
5. Once the car meets specifications and is received at registration, it is considered impounded until the conclusion of the race.
6. No modifications shall be allowed once the car is impounded.
7. In the event of a wreck whereby the car can no longer run, a five (5) minute grace period shall be allowed for the owner to repair the car. The car must still meet specifications outlined in rule 1. If the owner does not start the repairs BEFORE the next scheduled race, their car will be disqualified.
8. The race will be determined by fastest times, and not by elimination.
9. Each car will race down all four (4) lanes. The slowest time will be thrown out and the three fastest times will be averaged. Top three average times win.
10. The format of the race may be modified by the host based on number of participants.
11. All rulings by the host are final.
