Adrienne is a multi-hyphenate producer, actor and singer-songwriter based in Vancouver, known for her versatile musical style that spans pop, folk, synthwave, chillwave, chamber pop, electropop and melodic techno. With a background in arts and science, Adrienne founded Marigold Music Inc. and [Yaletown Records](#), where she's dedicated to fostering creative authenticity and artistic mastery.

Adrienne showcased her musical talents in Montreal as a bassoonist and trumpet player in various youth orchestras and jazz bands growing up, and as a member of the F.A.C.E. Treble Choir for several years, notably singing with the choir on the 1997

Juno Award-winning recording ([Best Classical Album - Vocal or Choral Performance](#)) of Hector Berlioz's *La Damnation de Faust* (The Damnation of Faust) which featured the Montreal Symphony Orchestra and Choruses directed by Charles Dutoit.

More recently her musical journey included being a member of the West Coast folk band Fallow State from 2017-2020, releasing two EPs and winning the 2019 [Whistler Music Search Competition](#).

As a solo artist Adrienne released several singles prior to releasing her debut [EP - These Winter Skies](#) in 2023 with two singles on the album ([Stardust](#) and [I Need The Light](#)) garnering play on both CBC Radio One and college radio stations. She was also able to release 2 music videos for the project thanks to support from the FACTOR Artist Development program.

Adrienne's artistic training extends well beyond music, having performed in notable productions like *Les Miserables* and trained at prestigious institutions such as the National Ballet School she has an impressive [performance resume](#) in both acting and dance.

As a member of organizations such as the Songwriters Association of Canada, AFM, Music BC, SHE-Q Audio, UBCP | ACTRA and the UDA, Adrienne is still deeply involved in

the music and entertainment industry as an actor, singer-songwriter, recording engineer and music producer.
