#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Home Tuition Grant Scheme is to provide funding towards the provision of a compensatory educational service for

- Pre-School children aged between 2 ½ and 3 years with a diagnosis of autism
- Pre-School children aged from 3 years upwards who meet the scheme's eligibility criteria
- Students seeking a special school or special class placement in a recognised school

The aim of the Department is to meet the needs of families and to ensure every child is allocated a suitable school placement. The preferred approach is that children are educated in school settings where children may have access to fully qualified teachers, individualised education programmes, special needs assistants, school curriculum with the option, where possible and appropriate, of full or partial integration and interaction with student peers. Accordingly, Home Tuition is provided as an interim measure only for children for whom a placement in a recognised school is not currently available and should not be regarded as an optional alternative to a school placement.

#### **Important Notice**

No tuition should take place until written confirmation of tutor/s sanction has been issued to you by the Department and payment will not be made in respect of any tuition delivered prior to the approved dates.

The closing date for receipt of applications under the HTSEN1 strand of the scheme for the 2025/2026 school year is: **29th May 2026**.

The following periods will **not** be covered for payment for any student availing of the Home Tuition Grant Scheme:

October 2025 mid-term break: Monday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2025 to Friday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025 inclusive.

Christmas 2025: Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2025 to Friday 02<sup>nd</sup> January 2026 inclusive

February 2026 mid-term break: Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2026 to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 inclusive.

Easter 2026: Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2026 to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026 inclusive.

Bank Holidays: All bank holidays which fall within the school year

Home Tuition should reflect the school day and be provided between (9am–6pm). Home Tuition should not take place during school holidays, bank holidays and weekends.

Home tuition funding is only available on completion of the full application process which includes the issue of a grant approval letter by the Department of Education and Youth confirming the commencement date of the tuition. Applicants must not enter into any agreement with their proposed tutors in anticipation of funding until confirmation by the Department that their application has been approved. The Department will only grant payment from the sanction date as set out in its grant approval letter to the applicant.
- 3. Once the application is approved, only the applicant who has signed the form and whose name appears on the grant approval letter will be in a position to receive information in relation to the application and make the claim in relation to payment of the grant. This is to comply with Data Protection legislation.
- 4. Where an application is received from persons other than the parent of the student in question, it must include confirmation of guardianship, such as a placement order from TUSLA or a court order.
