Lapin Bleu, Merlot, France. 9/32
Corte Vigna, Pinot Grigio, Italy. 9/32

Red

La Mascota, Cabernet Sauvignon, Argentina. 12/39

This Cabernet is fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged for 18 months in French oak. It has ripe dark fruit, cassis, tobacco, chocolate, and oak spice, with medium tannins.

Leyda Reserva, Pinot Noir, Chile. 12/39

Red cherries, raspberries and blueberries with light notes of herbs and spices. Fresh fruit flavours with balanced acidity and gentle tannins. Perfect for our salmon dish.

Red Knott, Shiraz, Australia. 13/40

This extra dry Ozzy shiraz is big, with dark berry, herbs, and spice. Very herbaceous, balanced acid, medium tannins, and medium length.

Panizzi, Chianti Colli Senesi, Italy. 13/40

Fresh and lively on the palate, with hints of crunchy red fruits and long juicy finish. Medium-body, with silky tannins.

Jasci & Marchesani, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC, Italy. 14/42

Mature red fruits, jams, and slight notes of cinnamon and vanilla. Balanced and harmonious with a touch of pleasant tannins.

Tomas Cusine, Llebre, Tempranillo, Spain. 15/44

Cherry color with garnet reflections. Clean on the nose and smooth with well-integrated notes of red fruits, candy, vanilla and white pepper. Silky on the palate, fresh and elegant, with smooth tannins.

White

Reif Estate, Riesling, Niagara on the Lake. 11/35

A fan favourite, and one of our must haves. Flavours of ripe pear, floral, biscuit, raisins, and pine nuts; dry, medium-bodied with medium finish.

Henry Of Pelham, Chardonnay, Niagara on the Lake. 12/39

A great example of great Ontario winemaking. Bold, ripe fruit with pear, quince, vanilla, nuts, toast and a creamy, long mouthfeel.

Jasci & Marchesani, Trebbiano D'Abruzzo DOC, Italy. 13/40

Elegant with hints of mature yellow fruit, Spanish Broom flowers, and vanilla. Pleasant with good body, saltiness, and freshness, with final notes of white-pulp fruit and bitter almonds.

White Cliff, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand. 13/40

Light floral with gooseberry, grass and citrus aromas. This wine is extra dry, has medium body, and mouth filling fruit flavour.

Rose

JP Azeitao, Syrah, Portugal. 8.5/32

Aromas of red berries and cherry. The aromas are intensely echoed on the palate and supported by vibrant acidity, ending in a crisp finish that highlights the light mineral notes.

Banrock Station, Pink Moscato, Australia 9/33

Clear light pink with orange blossom, pear and fresh berry - strawberry, raspberry and cherry. Nice acidity and a slight effervescence.

Celliers Des Princes Le Triporteur Rose, Rhone, France. 12/39

Dry, beautiful pale pink colour, very aromatic with intense red fruit aromas and a mineral freshness. A perfect balance with the red fruits and white flowers

2022 Piattelli Luján de Cuyo Reserve Malbec, Argentina. 40

Flavours of mocha, fresh herbs, plum and blackberry with textured tannins and balancing acidity.

2022 Tomero, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina. 44

This wine is sourced from 20-year-old vines, with 20% of it aged in oak for eight months and the remainder aged in stainless steel. It's silky and engaging, with lifted florals and plentiful red and black fruit. An easy fit for ribs, roast turkey or roast veggies.

2021 Don't Tell Gary, Shiraz, Australia. 46

Melange of mulberry fragrant blueberry ripe fruit, smoke, meat spice, white pepper, good balance, and juicy finish.

2021 Clos de Luz Massal, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chili. 52

From the Clos de Luz property, in Almahue, in the center of the Cachapoal Valley. The fine - very fine - tannins underpin the body and juicy acidity in a fruity-style cabernet.

2020 Umberto Cesari Liano, Sangiovese/Cabernet Sauvignon, Italy. 59

Sangiovese and Cabernet. Big, dark, smoky, with floral and cedar notes. Absolutely perfect with any of our meatball dishes.

2021 Castelveccchi Chianti Classico Capotondo, Sangiovese, Italy. 65

The aroma of red fruits prevails, with ripe fruit such as berry berries, blueberry, cherry and plum, and slightly spicy. A wine of great harmony, typical and balanced, with great character.

2020 Tinta Fina, Tempranillo, Spain. 82

This wine is very powerful, structured and elegant. Aromas of blackberry compote, black fruit, hints of thyme and sage, wrapped in the tones of spices, roasted and toasted bread. Aged in French oak barrels and from 35-100 year old vines!

2019 Sidewood Mappinga Shiraz, Australia. 90

100% Shiraz. A dark and malty, concentrated wine with some spicy and whole bunch elements. There are bilberries, loganberries and a basket of wild Scottish dark blue fruits on the palate, with vanilla extract, earthy and savoury mushroom flavours.

2021 Castello Romitorio, Romitorio Toscana IGT, Italy. 110

A modern Super Tuscan in a gutsy, full-bodied package. Ample fruit, freshness, and quite a bit of body: the tannins are bold but countered by so much fruit that they attain an almost mocha vanilla sweetness and comes across smooth, dense, and full bodied.

2018 Castello Romitorio, Brunello Di Montalcino, Sangiovese, Italy. 190

It is a wine that expresses the Montalcino territory with purity and embodies the finest aspects of the area's longstanding tradition of cultivating world class Sangiovese. This classic Brunello is produced with Sangiovese grapes carefully harvested and selected by hand on the sorting table, both before and after destemming. The wine matures in oak for approximately 24 months, and after bottling the wine is aged in Castello Romitorio's temperature-controlled cellars for approximately an additional 12 months before release.
