Beringer, Cabernet Sauvignon, California. 8.5/32
Corte Vigna, Pinot Grigio, Italy. 8.5/32

Red

Mirassau, Pinot Noir, California. 11/35

A great light to medium body wine with notes of red plum, vanilla, toasted oak and licorice.

11th Hour Cellars, Cabernet Sauvignon, California. 12/39

Dark fruit flavors and aromas including rich cherry, plum and stone fruit. This Cabernet Sauvignon is a very enticing and versatile food companion, and great value for California.

Red Knott, Shiraz, Australia. 12/39

This extra dry Ozzy shiraz is big, with dark berry, herbs, and spice. Very herbaceous, balanced acid, medium tannins, and medium length.

Panizzi, Chianti Colli Senesi, Italy. 13/40

Fresh and lively on the palate, with hints of crunchy red fruits and long juicy finish. Medium-body, with silky tannins.

Jasci & Marchesani, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC, Italy. 14/42

Mature red fruits, jams, and slight notes of cinnamon and vanilla. Balanced and harmonious with a touch of pleasant tannins.

Tomas Cusine, Llebre, Tempranillo, Spain. 15/44

Cherry color with garnet reflections. Clean on the nose and smooth with well-integrated notes of red fruits, candy, vanilla and white pepper. Silky on the palate, fresh and elegant, with smooth tannins.

White

Reif Estate, Riesling, Niagara on the Lake. 11/35

A fan favourite, and one of our must haves. Flavours of ripe pear, floral, biscuit, raisins, and pine nuts; dry, medium-bodied with medium finish.

Henry Of Pelham, Chardonnay, Niagara on the Lake. 12/39

A great example of great Ontario winemaking. Bold, ripe fruit with pear, quince, vanilla, nuts, toast and a creamy, long mouthfeel.

Jasci & Marchesani, Trebbiano D'Abruzzo DOC, Italy. 13/40

Elegant with hints of mature yellow fruit, Spanish Broom flowers, and vanilla. Pleasant with good body, saltiness, and freshness, with final notes of white-pulp fruit and bitter almonds.

White Cliff, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand. 13/40

Light floral with gooseberry, grass and citrus aromas. This wine is extra dry, has medium body, and mouth filling fruit flavour.

Southbrook Vineyards Triomphe Orange, Niagara on the Lake. 13/40

Orange wines have taken the wine world by storm, and this is one of the best examples. 65% Chardonnay Musqué, 35% Vidal. Citrus aromas and beautiful floral notes for this easy sipping wine.

Rose

JP Azeitao, Syrah, Portugal. 8.5/32

Aromas of red berries and cherry. The aromas are intensely echoed on the palate and supported by vibrant acidity, ending in a crisp finish that highlights the light mineral notes.

Banrock Station, Pink Moscato, Australia 9/33

Clear light pink with orange blossom, pear and fresh berry - strawberry, raspberry and cherry. Nice acidity and a slight effervescence.

Celliers Des Princes Le Triporteur Rose, Rhone, France. 12/39

Dry, beautiful pale pink colour, very aromatic with intense red fruit aromas and a mineral freshness. A perfect balance with the red fruits and white flowers.

2018 The Hedonist, Shiraz, Australia. 42

100% Shiraz. Deep, dark and inky aromatics of plush eucalyptus, licorice and blueberry. This wine is earthy with dried herb, rich chocolate, and graceful tannins on the palate. A perfect pairing with our Sirloin with peppercorn sauce.

2019 Zaha, Toko Vineyard, Malbec, Argentina. 50

Co-fermented with 12% Cabernet Franc and 3% Petit Verdot from the Toko vineyard in Paraje Altamira, Uco Valley.. Purplish red in the glass, with fresh plum, cherry and violets. This is a textbook example of a great Malbec.

2019 Feudo Disisa Vulkà Etna Rosso DOC, Italy. 52

A blend of Nerello Mascalese and Nerello Cappuccio, and is an authentic expression of the terroir of Etna, but characterized by a unique combination of elegance and drinkability. The volcanic origin and the altitude of the vineyards give this wine a remarkable minerality and a great character.

2020 Erath Pinot Noir, Oregon. 54

This is a bang-on Oregon Pinot, with smoky, licorice, red plum, blood orange and earthy aromas and flavours. Extra dry, medium-bodied and supple.

2020 Umberto Cesari Liano, Sangiovese/Cabernet Sauvignon, Italy. 60

A fantastic blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet. Big, dark, smoky, with floral and cedar notes. Absolutely perfect with any of our meatball dishes.

2020 Decoy, Cabernet Sauvignon, California. 69

A go to wine with complex dark fruit, chocolate, minerality, cedar and toast.

2016 Brigaldara Cavolo Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy 95

As big as they get. Deep, dense, hauntingly dark, rich, with brown spices giving way to balsam herbs and macerated cherries, red fruits and molten chocolate, all supported by brisk acids that balance its heady character perfectly. Long length. Cavolo is a cooler vineyard location, with an eastern exposure balanced by stony soils that absorb the heat of the sun.

2020 Caymus-Suisun Grand Durif, Suisun Valley, California. 120

Wow this wine is opulent and luxuriously soft. Suisun Valley is still largely undiscovered. With its warm days and cool nights, this pastoral region reminds us of Napa Valley in the 1960s. Known for delicious stone fruits and walnuts, it is also gaining recognition for exceptional wine. Durif is synonymous with Petite Sirah, the widely grown grape in the region. With harmonious tannins, this wine is opulent, luxuriously soft and totally enjoyable.

2020 Austin Hope, Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, California. 130

The emergence of Paso Robles as a fine-wine region is intimately tied to the efforts of the Hope family. This Cabernet is dark and ripe, with black cherry, blackberry, mocha, vanilla, clove, black pepper spice and velvety tannins. An expressive, approachable wine that's perfectly suited to accompany thick steaks and prime rib.

2020 Camus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California. 180

From one of Napa's pioneering wine families and possessing all that premium Cali Cab's have to offer - crème de cassis, cocoa, and anise. This is definitely a trophy wine, and perfect for any Prospector steak.
