

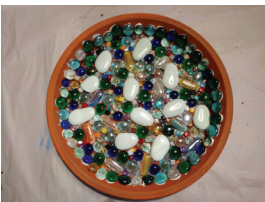


# Please Join us for GCI's 96<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention "My Garden... My Oasis" April 16-17, 2023

## **Hands-on Garden Water Element with Krina Kronen – Sunday 2:30-4:00 pm**

The first is a pinecone bird feeder that can be taken back to our clubs as a garden therapy project for our clients. The second is the creation of a terra cotta mosaic water element which will help us maintain a water supply in our gardens for birds over the winter.



## **Afternoon Bird Walk at Herrick Lake Forest Preserve – Sunday 2:30-4:00 pm**

Donna Kubik of the DuPage Birding Club will lead a bird walk and teach about local and migratory birds at Herrick Lake Forest Preserve located about four miles from the Chicago Marriott Naperville hotel. Binoculars will be provided along with instruction on how to effectively use them to get up close and personal with birds, revealing their intricate features and opening a window on their lives. ## **Birds in the Garden: Creating a Bird Oasis with Pam Karlson – Monday 9:00 am**

This program features Pam Karlson's photos from her Chicago garden habitat she created, illustrating how it is possible to attract over 100 bird species. Tips include landscape enhancements, practices, and plant selection, with an emphasis on native plants. Pam's garden habitat was included in Doug Tallamy's "Nature's Best Hope: A New Approach to Conservation That Starts in Your Yard". A professional gardener and garden designer through the Chicago Botanic Garden, she owns Waxwing Studios, Inc. with her artist husband, specializing in art and gardening.
