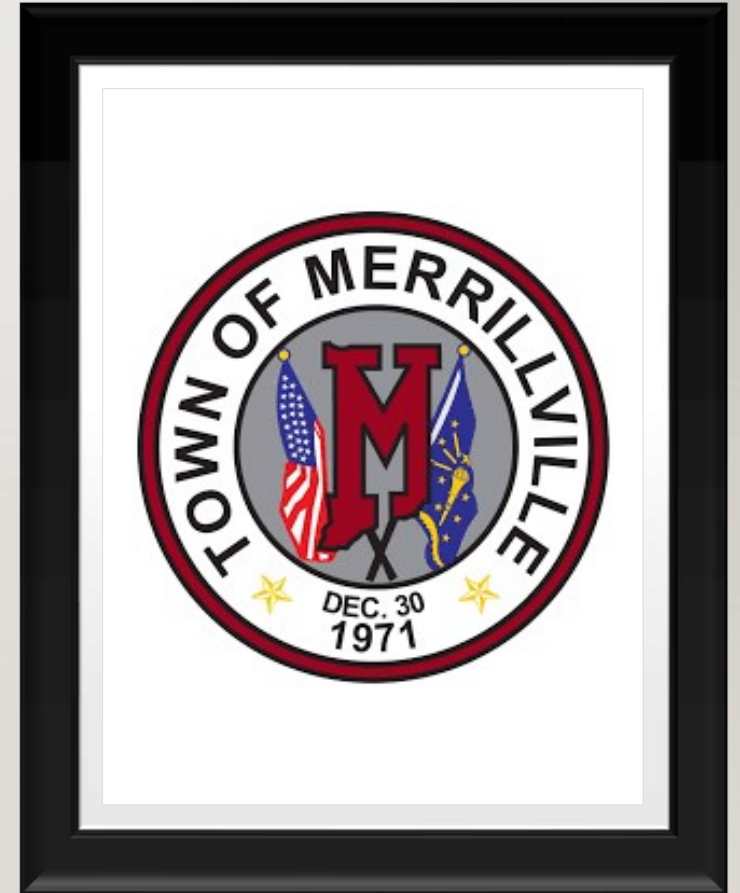

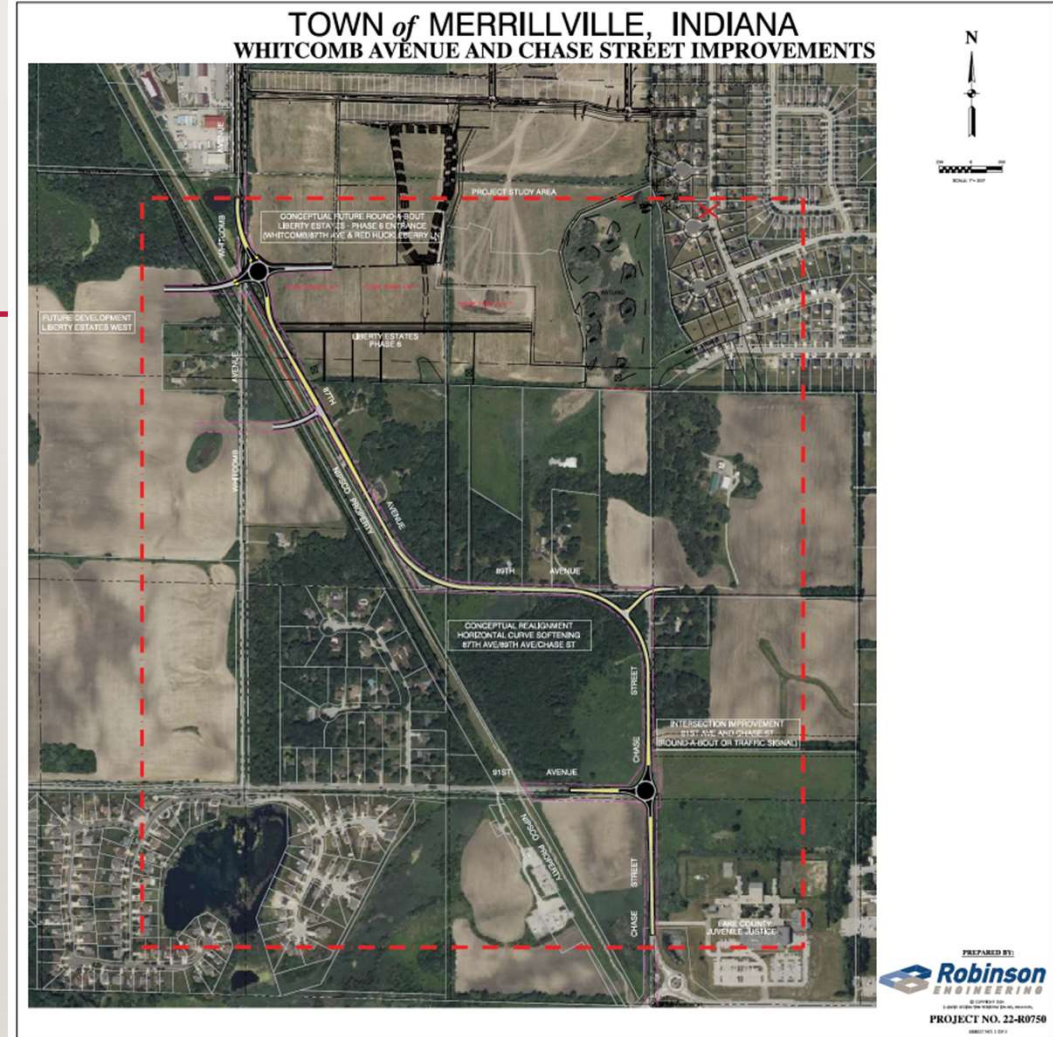

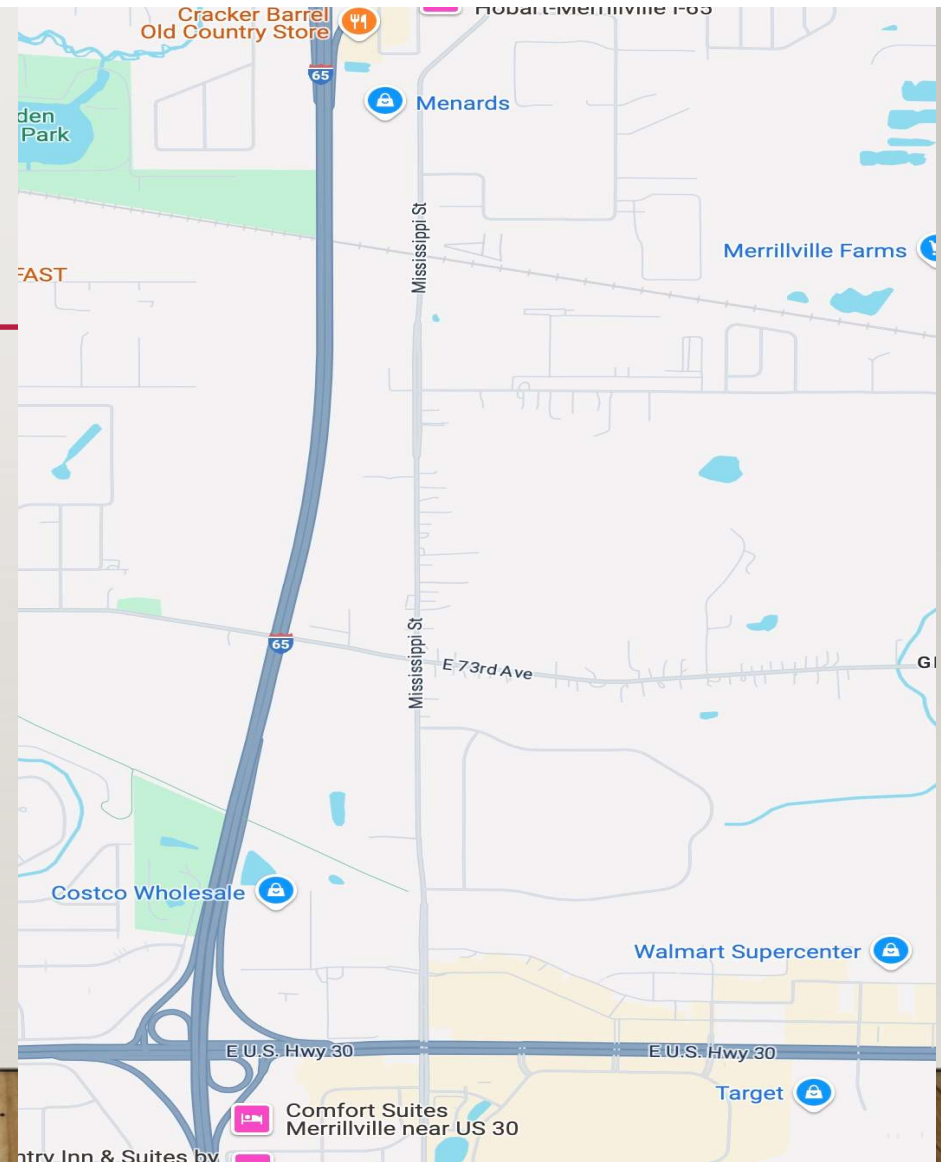
# WHITCOMB AVENUE & CHASE STREET

- Road and Intersection Improvements
  - Designed in part to support the new Liberty Estates 2 Development
  - It is in design, conceptual phase, but could include roundabouts at Whitcomb Street & 86<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Chase Street



# MISSISSIPPI STREET CORRIDOR

- Enhancements between 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue and US 30
  - The Project is in final design and right of way acquisition status.
  - It is a multi-phase project which includes a round a bout at 69<sup>th</sup> and Mississippi.
  - The second phase of this project is a proposed Round a bout at 79th Ave and Mississippi





The current location is at 9254 Old Lincoln Highway  
This is the extreme northeast of our coverage area.

With the growth of residential and commercial developments  
and rising call volume in the southeast district, this location is  
no longer feasible.

# THE LOCATION OF THE NEW STATION 73

- Location chosen to best impact the homeowner ISO rating.
- The Fire Station is within 5 miles of residence.
- Fire hydrant within 1,000

It is intended that the new station will have an ALS Ambulance and staffed with full time personnel It will have an Engine Company/Tanker staffed with Part-time and volunteer firefighters





# MERRILLVILLE FIRE STATIONS (MERRILLVILLE ROSS TOWNSHIP FIRE TERRITORY)

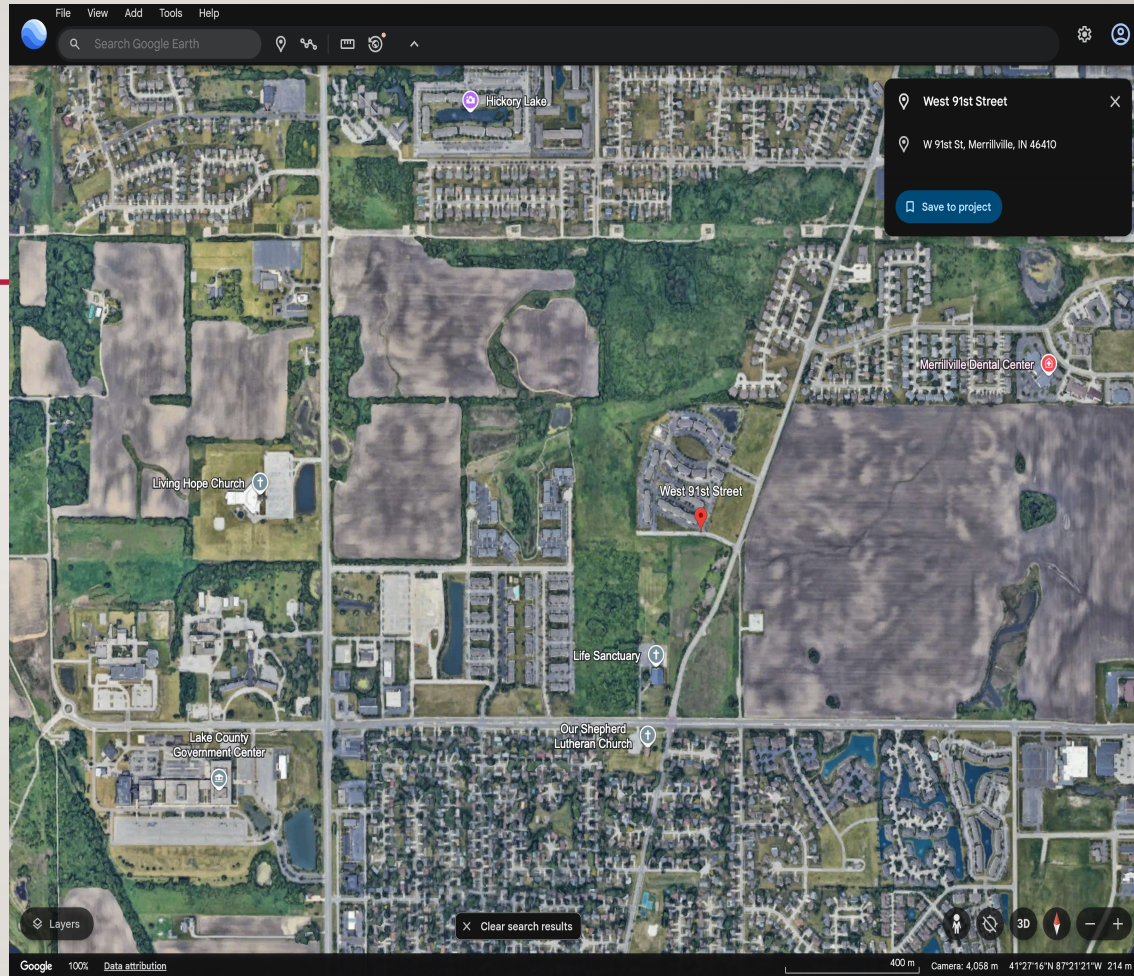


## • Existing Fire Stations

- Station 72 • 7905 Taft Street
- Station 73 • 9254 Old Lincoln Highway (proposed to be retired.)
- Station 74 • 850 West 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- NEW STATION 73 around Colorado & 93rd

# CONNECTING MERRILLVILLE & SCHERERVILLE WITH SIDEWALK LINKING BIKE TRAILS

- A project that is still under study
- It is hoped to identify and construct a wide sidewalk along the former Pennsy line, south of 91<sup>st</sup> Street and to run along or parallel to it.
