NEW JERSEY

2C:58-4.4 Safety requirements, handgun carry.

- 5. Safe carry requirements for authorized holders of a permit to carry a handgun.
- a. The holder of a permit to carry a handgun issued pursuant to N.J.S.2C:58-4 shall not:
- (1) use or consume alcohol, a cannabis item, or a controlled substance while carrying a handgun;
- (2) be under the influence of alcohol, cannabis, or a controlled substance while carrying a handgun;
- (3) carry a handgun in public outside of a holster or carry a handgun in public in a holster that does not meet the requirements of subsection h. of N.J.S.2C:58-4;
- (2C:58-4 Permits to carry handguns. h. For purposes of this section, "holster" means a device or sheath that securely retains a handgun which, at a minimum, conceals and protects the main body of the firearm, maintains the firearm in a consistent and accessible position, and renders the trigger covered and inaccessible while the handgun is fully seated in the holster.)
 - (4) carry more than two firearms under the permittee's control at one time; or
 - (5) engage in an unjustified display of a handgun.

A violation of this subsection shall be a crime of the fourth degree, and any such violation shall constitute full and sufficient grounds for revocation of a permit to carry a handgun issued pursuant to N.J.S.2C:58-4.

NEW YORK CITY

NYC § 5-22 Conditions of Issuance.

- (7) If the licensee has a "Carry" or "Special Carry" type license **only one** (1) handgun may be carried on their person at any time.
- (11) The licensee shall not draw, expose or display handgun(s) unnecessarily.

§ 5-24 Gun Custodians and Carry Guards.

(2) A licensee has the responsibility of making an immediate report to the Division Head, License Division, the precinct where the incident occurred, and

the gun custodian or alternate custodian in the following instances:

(v) Public display of an unholstered handgun.
