

## **CONCEAL CARRY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

The NYS prohibition is extremely broad and inclusive:

(n) any place, conveyance, or vehicle used for public transportation or public transit, subway cars, train cars, buses, ferries, railroad, omnibus, marine or aviation-transportation; or any facility used for or in connection with service in the transportation of passengers, airports, train stations, subway and rail stations, and bus terminals;

New Jersey does not consider public transportation to be prohibited for carry. Rather only as it relates to school buses:

“(7) a school, college, university or other educational institution, and on any school bus;”

But, the “hub” (station) would be prohibited:

(20) an airport or public transportation hub;
