Park Commission – Discussion on allowing Church to have a community get together in the park on ay 20th. They will have 3 fire rings and keep them on the rock surface where Rob told them would be ok. Discussion held on installing camera system in the park. Issue will be brought up at the Fire Company meeting in May to pay half of the cost for the system and installation.

For the Good of the Community: Discussion on burning in the borough. Tabled for further discussion. Discussion on handicap accessibility for the park. April Karns asked if something could be done because the park is not handicap/wheelchair friendly. Discussed options for Path to park, wood, pavers etc. Jim will look at the park and check regarding a direct path with a limited grade change.
