Reporting Requirements Not Met for Millvile Municipal Water Authority

We violated a drinking water reporting requirement.

What should I do?
There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arised where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.
What happened? What was done?
There was a clerical error made on the chain of custody for a total coliform sample taken on 8/5/2025 and the associated distribution chlorine residual. Our laboratory is submitting a correction request to DEP to fix the record.
Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
