#### Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Millville Municipal Authority

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 2020 and 2021 we failed to monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.*

#### What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, the required sampling frequency, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which corrective action samples were (or will be) taken.

#### What happened? What was done? When will it be resolved?

During 2020 and 2021 Millville Municipal Authority failed to monitor for various contaminants listed above. Millville MA has entered into a Consent Order and Agreement with DEP to correct deficiencies and bring the water treatment plant into compliance with all regulations. In the future Millville Municipal Authority will create a sampling calendar at the beginning of each year, followed by entering those dates into outlook or similar notification software as reminders.
