- 448 million tons of plastic is produced in a year.
- Coca Cola is the largest producer of plastic bottles 128 billion a year; Pepsi and Nestles is not far behind.
- China is the largest producer of plastics, accounting for 25% of the global supply; most of which they export.
- The seas surrounding Asian countries have been decimated by plastic trash.
- Only 18% of plastics are recycled globally.
