Our Founding Story

Lovie's Pearls was founded in 2012 by Elisha (Divinity) Weatherton. She shares, "In 2007, I was listening to Oprah talk about her school for girls that she started in Africa, and I began to seriously ponder in what way I could help others. I say "seriously" because I have always liked helping people and did so privately in whatever way I could. But this desire that I began to feel was bigger than that, and what came to me was homes for teenage mothers. Wow, I thought! Where did that come from? Right away, I knew it was from God. It was nothing that I could have come up with on my own because I did not know there was a need for it. It would take me years to fully understand just how much of a need it truly is.

After relocating to Houston, TX (from Los Angeles, CA) in 2009, and taking some time to get settled, I began to put more thought into the vision God had given me; and in 2012 I established *Lovie's Pearls* as a nonprofit organization. Of course, coming up with the name was no simple task, but just as God gave me the vision, He also gave me the name. I initially came up with Divinity House but wanted to represent both sides of my family. So, I played around with names, even ones that were non-family related. Then it hit me! My paternal grandmother's name was Lovie and my maternal grandmother's name was Pearlina. *Lovie's Pearls* was perfect!!! In my vision for this organization, I knew love would be one of the key ingredients in reshaping the lives of these teen moms, and I remembered what I had learned about how pearls are made. I knew then I was on to something that was much bigger than me.

Unfortunately, with some of life's ups and downs, there were several stops, starts and delays in getting Lovie's Pearls off the ground. But the thoughts, ideas and passion for it would not leave me alone! In 2018 I became determined that I would start again and **not** stop. However, I thought that trying to create housing for the teen moms was too big of a project for me. I tried to kick-off the support groups that I and a couple of others created a curriculum for, but to no avail. It was a slow and disappointing process until I finally realized that nothing was going to work until I got back to the vision God gave me, "homes for teenage mothers". I had to remember this was not about me and therefore was not about what I could do, but what He could do through me. As soon as I wrapped my brain around this, things seemed to begin to fall into place. In April 2019, I met Dr. Pamela Ogletree (I literally chased after her when I noticed she was preparing to leave a conference we had both attended). That chance encounter led to an extended phone conversation, followed by an amazing lunch meeting. From that was birthed a beautiful partnership predicated on helping teen moms. Dr. O brought me in as a guest speaker to share Lovie's Pearls with her teen mom students. To my delight, they were interested in becoming a part of our program. On December 21, 2019, we hosted our first annual Christmas Luncheon. With the help of sponsors, we granted the wishes of nine teen moms and gave away a large number of donated items. That is how Lovie's Pearls was founded!"



Building Great Futures

To date, *Lovie's Pearls* has impacted over 200 lives through our Outreach Reach Program! We've created a comprehensive Outreach Program that covers a wide range of areas crucial for the development and success of these young moms. From empowerment and money matters to selfcare, parenting tips, healthy relationships, CPR training, career workshops, and more. *Lovie's Pearls* offers a holistic approach to help these young moms thrive. We have awarded \$11,000 in scholarships and put over \$36,500 into our Outreach Program. And so, with the help of Dr. Pamela Ogletree, Melanee (Orellana) Rivera, and Elizabeth (Bolden) Leonard, *Lovie's Pearls* became a staple of Klein ISD's Parenting Education Program. The rest is still history in the making!

Programs & Services

- Scholarship Program: We awarded \$5,000 in scholarships, bringing our total to \$11,000.
- Workshops: We have provided monthly workshops on financial literacy, parenting, career development, self-care, healthy relationships, CPR/First Aid training, and college financial aid applications, which have empowered our teen moms with essential life skills.
- Golf Tournament: Our inaugural golf tournament was a great success. Special thanks to our sponsors and golfers who came out and had a great time!
- Daily Essentials: We assisted our teen moms with diapers, wipes, toiletries, and other daily necessities for them and their babies.
- We received appreciation certificates from the Klein ISD Health Services Department and Klein ISD School Board for our support of their teen mom students.



Financial Report


Annual Growth

Thanks to community support, *Lovie's Pearls* has been able to grow to meet increasing need over the past 5 years, and we are looking forward to new ways to service our teen moms.




2023 Income & Expenses
