STEM Scholarship – Science, Technology,
Engineering, and Mathematics

Purpose:

To provide a Mars Area High School Senior with a \$2000 non-renewable scholarship to help defray costs of the first year post-secondary education.

Criteria:

- Student must have a 2.5 QPA or above.
- Student must be accepted or enrolled for the upcoming school year in a technical school, community college, or 4-year college or university.
- Student plans on pursuing a future career in one of the STEM fields – Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics.

Applicants must submit the following information:

- Cover page with name, address, telephone number, and email.
- An essay discussing your future career goals, when you first knew that STEM was the career path for you, and how your choice of study or major in one of the STEM fields will help you achieve your goal(s). In your essay also include what sparked your interest or passion for your chosen field of study.
- Submit a transcript.
- Submit a letter of acceptance to a post-secondary school.

Submission of Application:

- Your application must be RECEIVED no later than **Friday April 1st, 2022.**
- A completed application includes all the information requested in the above list.
- Scholarships will be formally awarded at the Mars Area High School Academic Banquet.

Applications are to be submitted to Ms. Beth Yankel in the High School Guidance Office by April 1st, 2022.
