The Edward and Bethel Kean Foundation Scholarship for the Arts

Purpose:

To provide a Mars Area High School Senior with a \$2000 non-renewable scholarship to help defray costs of the first year post-secondary education.

Criteria:

- Student must have a 2.5 QPA or above.
- Student must have participated in the arts while in High School (i.e. orchestra, band, chorus, art classes, graphic arts, photography, drama productions, etc).
- Student must be accepted or enrolled for the upcoming school year in a technical school, community college, or 4-year college or university.

Applicants must submit the following information:

- Cover page with name, address, telephone number, and email.
- An essay discussing how your participation in the arts has influenced your growth as a student and a person during your high school years and how you anticipate the arts will continue to be a significant and influential part of your life throughout college and beyond.
- Submit a transcript.
- Submit a letter of acceptance from a post-secondary school.

Submission of Application:

- A completed application includes all the information requested in the above list.
- Scholarships will be formally awarded at the Mars Area High School Academic Banquet.
