Turnitin: Dr. McMahon

Turnitin is a plagiarism app that scans documents to alert teachers if an assignment has been copied or lifted from the Web. MASD has already ordered Turnitin for the High School and Dr. McMahon inquired if MPF would like to sponsor the purchase.

Treasurer Report - Andrea Bowser:

Andrea had emailed the MPF members a current financial statement. Andrea noted that

- Funds were received in the amount of \$5,000 from The John and Carrie Austin Family Fund in memory of Cody Kier, class of 2007. There are no use designations for this contribution.
- Funds were received in the amount of \$10,000 from the Butler County Grant Application.

Dayle Ferguson suggested that MPF present the "Walk Around Mars" event, concept, and challenge at the upcoming MASD School Board Meetings and Township Meetings. The presentations will generate more teams, awareness, and sponsor opportunities.

New Business:

The board discussed Proposed Bylaw changes. These changes will take vote at the next meeting and ratify by March 2021.

Section 1.03. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin on the 1st day of January July each year.

Section 2.02. Qualification and Selection. [a] Three (3) directors shall be current members of the Mars Area School District Board of School Directors and who shall be appointed annually by the Mars Area School District Board of School Directors. [b] (no changes) [c] The Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent of the Mars Area School District shall be an ex officio, non-voting member of the Board. Section 2.03. Term of Office. Each director appointed from among the residents of the Mars Area School District shall hold office for three (3) years until his or her successor shall have been elected and qualified, or until his or her earlier death, resignation, or removal. The terms of two (2) directors shall end each year. The directors initially appointed from among the residents of the Mars Area School District shall serve initial terms as follows: three shall serve for one (1) year; three shall serve for two (2) years; and three shall serve for three (3) years. Thereafter, all directors shall serve for terms of three (3) years

Vickie Zaccari also presented the option of expanding the MPF board. Vickie shared the board sizes of other districts: NA-17, Pine Richland - 17, Butler - 31, and Seneca - 15.
