

IPEVO Document Camera From Colleen Hinrichsen STEAM Teacher, Elementary & Centennial Schools


We are so grateful for our IPEVO Document Camera! I use it daily with my students in STEAM. Some of our learning resources are very small, like little robots or wire connections. By digitally capturing the up-close liveview, I can show those things on our large Promethean panel in the room! Students can get a better understanding of how to operate the different objects.







Rather than having to ask me to show them again individually (up close), students can see those details from the start and begin the learning challenge immediately. I can annotate over the video or pictures so I can label specific parts for students. Some of our robots are programmed through an app on the iPads. I am able to use the document camera to show the robot and the iPad programming at the same time. Students also love having a chance to present their robot programs in action to the class on the "big screen" by using the IPEVO! Any chance they get, no matter the project, they love showing their unique projects on the "big screen" for all classmates. Now, more than ever, it is especially treasured. If we have an object in the room to show, students seated (spaced apart) at the back of the room can see it, all while students at home can see it! Due to it being digitally captured, I can share the screen with LSI students. The overhead camera would be unable to capture those small details. This little gem has gone above and beyond for us, and we certainly cannot imagine a day of school without it! On behalf of my students and myself, we thank you!

Student engagement is extremely high when using the tables and many creative ideas and solutions are generated. Enabling students to collaborate in colorful and creative ways is a lot of fun for the students, but more importantly I have seen greater participation from students who normally remain quiet or disengage during classroom activities. I've also seen students feel freer to generate and share "outside the box" solutions to problems that allow their peers to potentially find alternative ways to solve problems which they may not have come up with individually. Whether the task requires independent work, partner work, or small group work, these tables allow my students to express themselves fully and creatively.
