- Student must be accepted or enrolled for the upcoming school year in an accredited technical school, community college, or 4-year college or university.
- Student must have a minimum of a 3.0 QPA.

- Letter of acceptance to post-secondary school.
- Please write a one-to-two-page essay explaining: HOW WOULD YOU PERSUADE SOMEONE WHO HAS NEVER PARTICIPATED IN THE MUSICAL BEFORE TO TAKE PART (NO MATTER HOW BIG OR SMALL THE ROLE) IN NEXT YEAR'S MUSICAL?
- Please include your name on the essay.
- Musical Director Evaluation and One Teacher Evaluation (sealed envelope)
- A copy of your transcript
